Control statistics were produced from results accumulated in the April-2016 round robin. A total of 172 fire assay results and 54 results from an aqua regia technique were used to certify this material.

## Material Description

This material is described as a Gold ore Minor Copper Composite.

# Colour Designation (ISCC-NBS, SP440)

This material is light gray in colour.

#### Usage

This product is for use in the mining industry as a reference material for monitoring and testing the accuracy of laboratory assaying.

## Preparation and Packaging

All CRMs are dried in an oven for a minimum of 12 hours at 110°C. The dry material is then pulverised to better than 75 micron (nominal mean of 45 micron) using an air classifier. The material is then homogenised and stored in a sealed, stable container ready for final packaging.

Materials are statistically sampled from stores, then packaged into either heat sealed, air tight, plastic pulp packets or screw top sealed plastic containers ready for distribution. All packaging has been chosen to ensure minimal contamination from outside sources during shipment, use and storage.
